

## **PROMOTION POLICY**

Upper School students are earning Carnegie units toward graduation. Each semester of credit counts as ½ Carnegie unit. To receive a full credit in a course, the student must pass the second semester of the course and have a final average of 68 or higher in that course. A minimum of 6 credits is required for sophomore status; a minimum of 11 credits is required for junior status; and, a minimum of 16 credits is required for senior status.

Middle School students must pass English, Math, Science, and Social Studies or Reading plus one of their elective courses to be promoted to the next grade. If there is any question concerning whether a student should pass or fail because the above criteria have not been met, the final decision will be made by the middle school teachers and the Headmaster.

The Lower School students will be promoted on an individual basis considering the following: grades, attendance, emotional maturity, intellectual maturity, and physical maturity.
