1. APPLICATION FEE
New students must complete the required application forms. *A non-refundable fee of \$50.00 must accompany the new student's application.* New students are admitted according to the general admissions requirements and availability policy. The application fee is a one-time fee.
2. ENROLLMENT FEE
A non-refundable enrollment fee of \$400.00 per child is due by February 22, 2018. The enrollment fee does not count as part of tuition. Upon acceptance of the student's application, receipt of the enrollment fee, and a signed enrollment agreement, the student will be officially enrolled for the 2018-2019 school year.
3. FAMILY MEMBERSHIP FEE
A nonrefundable fee of \$200.00 per family is required of those families not owning Monroe Educational Foundation stock or a Family Membership Certificate. You may contact the school office if interested in purchasing MEF stock or a Family Membership Certificate. The membership fee does not count as part of tuition.
4. TECHNOLOGY FEE
A Technology Fee of \$300 applies to every student in grades 6 – 12 and will provide each upper school student a Chromebook for 24/7 usage, replacement insurance for the device, eBook version of applicable textbooks, senior ownership of a Chromebook upon graduation, and maintenance or replacement of classroom Smartboards, document cameras, or said like equipment as needed. The River Oaks Board of Trustees will determine if this fee needs to adjusted or eliminated after the 2018-2019 school year.
5. YEARBOOK (Silver Spur)
Each family is charged \$75.00 for a yearbook. If you want additional yearbooks, please indicate the number of additional yearbooks you want at \$75 per yearbook on your Enrollment Agreement.
6. ANNUAL GIVING
This year you may add your Annual Giving gift (*a voluntary tax-deductible donation*) to either of our three payment plans. Please indicate on the line to the right how much you are willing to donate to the Annual Giving Fund this year. \$ _____

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP INCENTIVES

Credit of ½ tuition will be awarded to those who have an ACT Composite Score equal to or above the scores listed below. ACT scores earned during the 2017-2018 school year are applicable to the 2018-2019 school year. For example, an 8th grader makes a score of 27 during the 8th grade year, he/she qualifies for the 1/2 scholarship as a 9th & 10th grader. He/she does not qualify for a scholarship in the 8th grade.

Grades 11 & 12	29 ACT Composite Score
Grades 9 & 10	27 ACT Composite Score
Grades 7 & 8	25 ACT Composite Score

Credit of ¼ tuition will be awarded to those who have an ACT Composite Score equal to or above the scores listed below. ACT scores earned during the 2017-2018 school year are applicable to the 2018-2019 school year. For example, a 10th grader makes a score of 28 during the 10th grade year, he/she qualifies for a ¼ scholarship for the 11th & 12th grade. He/she does not qualify for a ¼ scholarship the 10th grade.
