

River Oaks Procedures for Phase Two

Developed using the Strong Start 2020 Reopening Guidelines

- All students will be offered face to face or virtual learning.
- Drop-off and pick-up times will be staggered to encourage smaller numbers of students at these times.
- Google classroom is offered in each room and classes will be recorded and uploaded as necessary.
- Face coverings for grades 3-12 are required (except for those with breathing difficulties as identified by the CDC.)
- Students in PK-2nd will be offered face shields to be used if parents would like.
- Teachers will have masks and face shields as required for specific age groups.
- Temperatures will be checked upon arrival and again in the middle of the day. Parents should take temps before coming to school to avoid problems.
- Any student with a temp of 100.4 will not be allowed to enter the building. Parents should wait until being given the all clear before they leave the parking lot. Upper/Middle students will enter separate doors in the Upper School.
- Students developing a temperature during the day will be sent to the Covid room to wait to be picked up. A return to school form will be filled out with a doctor's excuse before the student may return to school.
- Students will pick up a grab-and-go lunch from the cafeteria and will then eat in a designated area outside, in the classroom, or in the cafeteria. Each class will have a designated spot.
- Classes have been socially distanced. Groups in the Lower School will stay together as much as possible throughout the day.
- When students change classes shared surfaces will be sanitized.
- Door handles, light switches, bathrooms, etc. will be sanitized throughout the day.
- Middle school students will change classes via the halls. Upper school students will change via outside classroom doors, weather permitting.
- Appropriate signage has been installed to encourage students to walk on one side of the hall and stay at least 6 feet apart in line in all areas of the school.
- Break will also be separate with middle schoolers using the gym and upper in the cafeteria.
- Water fountains will only be used for filling water bottles. A hand sanitizer dispenser will be mounted on the wall by the fountains and should be used after filling bottles.
- Lower school students will have extra water bottles in the classrooms.
- Frequent hand washing/sanitizing will be encouraged throughout the day.
- Students will be given additional 'outside time' during the day to be without masks but will still social distance as needed.
